It is important to discuss this plan, KCTCS graduation requirements and EKV B.S. entrance requirements with your KCTCS advisor, as well as an EKV advisor. Students planning to transfer to EKV are encouraged to join the Colonel Connection in their first semester at KCTCS to take full advantage of the transfer planning services.
