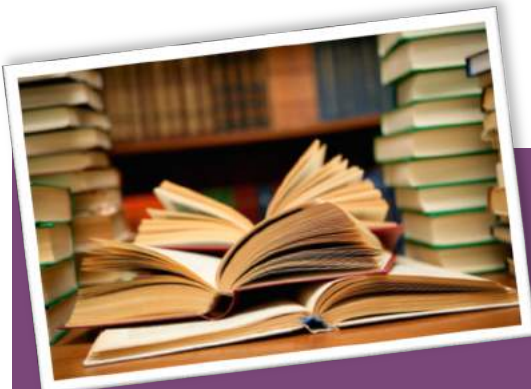

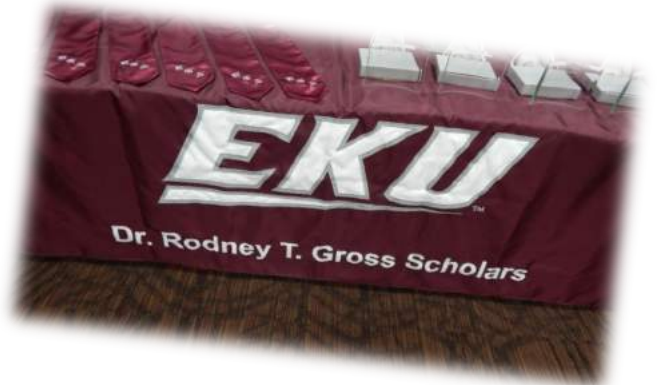
DECEMBER 6, 2016

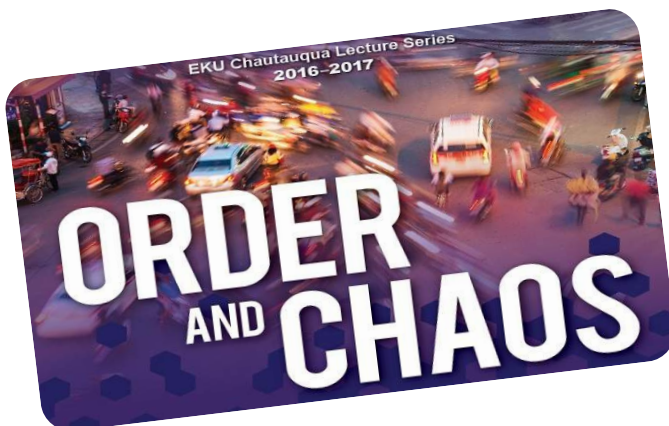
KENTUCKY ORAL HISTORY DAY
